Summer Handbook for Students in Maria's, Sara's and Jean and Maryhelen's Classes

- Session 1: June 11–22
- Session 2: June 25–July 6 (*school and childcare are closed on July 4*)
- Session 3: July 9–20
- Session 4: July 23–August 3
- Session 5: August 6-10 (*A special week-long program.*)

Location and Schedules

Jean and Maryhelen's class will be joined in their classroom by Sara's and Maria's students. Students should bring a pair of "inside" shoes that can be left at the school. That way they don't track dirt and mud into the classroom.

- Half-day classes are 9 AM-12 PM
- Full-day classes are 9 AM-3 PM
- All-day classes are 9 AM-5 PM
- All time before 9 AM and after 5 PM is childcare. Drop-in childcare is not available in the afternoons for half- or full-day students.

To drop off your child, please park, walk your child to Jean and Maryhelen's class, and sign them in daily on the class roster. Curbside drop-off is not available in the summer. You have a grace period of 10 minutes in the morning (8:50-9 AM) for dropping off your child. There is no grace period any other time.

Please sign your children out promptly at pick-up and take them home so that our staff may sign their children out on time. Thank you!

Medications and Sunscreen

Summer school medications: Be sure to check in any medication with the office. If you are a current MIR family, you need to fill out separate medication forms for summer school.

Sunscreen rules: Licensing rules classify sunscreen as a medication for Toddlers and Primary students. Send your child to summer school wearing sunscreen. For Toddler (18 mos.-3 years)

and Primary (3-6 years) students, parents will need to check in extra sunscreen with their child's teacher.

Sportball

Primary and Toddler students participate in Sportball during summer school. Sportball is high-energy and fun-filled while introducing the children to some basic sports fundamentals appropriate to their age.

Primary students participate in Sportball in the morning on the first Friday of each session. Please ensure children wear attire and closed-toe shoes good for sports.

Paying for Summer School

Summer school payments are to be made online using the same billing system you use for your school-year tuition payments. You can also pay in the office (no cash or credit card payments accepted).

- Session 1 payments are due Friday, June 8.
- Session 2 payments are due Friday, June 22.
- Session 3 payments are due Friday, July 6.
- Session 4 payments are due Friday, July 20.
- Session 5 payments are due Friday, August 3.

All activities are included in your summer school tuition. Summer school tuition and deposits are non-refundable.
